

***Supervisor Gonser's comments regarding Warren Brown
September 22, 2015***

"I wanted to express the disappointment I have in our former Township manager. The second week after he came, he asked the supervisor if I would turn over all the projects I was working on to him, which I did, and that was the last time I spoke to him, or he spoke to me actually. The last time he ... for a number of weeks. But it has really been disappointing:

- Township Hall parking lot refinishing – provided him with contacts and preliminary bids – Nothing happened*
- Front door replace – Provided him with contacts, budgetary cost and preliminary designs – Nothing happened*
- Eagle Creek Safety Path- Provided him with attorney contact, even took him to a meeting with the owner had the process pretty well along with the site plan work – Nothing happened*
- Paint Creek Bridge lights – Provided him with contact information and the scope of work – Nothing happened*
- Provided him the road plan with Rochester Hills and Road Commission of Oakland County with contacts and estimated costs – Nothing happened*
- Township Hall handicap ramp – Needs replacement, has three trip hazards as was pointed out last Monday during office hours – known last summer and again – the preliminary design work has been done and transferred to Mr. Brown – Nothing happened*
- Handicap rail refinishing proposal – Nothing happened*
- The brick to the pavement in front of night drop box – woman fell recently tripped over it – brought to his attention – Nothing happened*
- Community well enhancement program – Basically stalled*
- Rewrite office personnel manual – Nothing happened*
- Write a procurement policy- Nothing happened*
- Finish Security system for Township Hall- contact information and estimated costs were provided – Nothing happened*

- *Digitizing all Township records – contact information and preliminary bid information provided*

So it has been a very disappointing 5 months or whatever, he was on the Board, or on the staff. With all the information that was being worked on, and was being progressed, nothing has happened. And the only losers in this are the residents. And it is particularly disconcerting to know that we have a number of safety hazards that were known a year ago. Now we are at the end of the construction seasons, and nothing has happened. I find that absolutely unacceptable and it speaks to perhaps the commitment of managers who are not responsive to the residents of what does happen or doesn't happen when we have that form of government."
